BEPS Compliance

- DC Building Energy Performance Standards (BEPS)
 - Reduce greenhouse gas emission & energy consumption by 50% by 2032
 - Net Zero 2050
- Clean Energy DC Omnibus Act of 2018
- 2,129 Building in Washington DC to comply
- 931 buildings need to comply with BEPS legislation by April 1st, 2023
- Owners is required to choose a compliance path by April 1st, 2023
- Penalty \$10/GSF up to \$7.5M



Key Obstacles:

Prioritize capital costs and Education of Building Owners

- Huge cost of design upgrades
- COVID-19 Financial strain
- Cost of hiring Consultants

- Stringent timeline and COVID effect






Benefits:
