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




DGS Sustainability Goals: Clean Energy Act

Building Energy Performance Standards (BEPS)

- At DGS we are heavily focused on the Act's Building Energy Performance Standards (BEPS) and subsequently the development of our Strategic Energy Management Plan (SEMP)
- BEPS establishes, over multiple compliance periods, minimum energy performance thresholds for all DC government buildings 10,000 sq. ft. and greater
