UPDATES:

- In support of DOEE's work to develop the Affordable Housing Retrofit Accelerator (AHRA), AEG had an October event that piloted outreach and intake to affordable housing building owners
- DOEE's AHRA launched in FY22 w/ ~\$34 million budget
 - 37 affordable multifamily buildings currently receiving: tailored BEPS financial & technical support, ASHRAE level 2 energy audits, building upgrades
- Trainings launched: Hub's "Train-the-Trainer," community partnership training planning, DCSEU programs, ECC working group
- Policy recommendations: ongoing through BEPS Cycle 1 (2026)
