UPDATES:

- Completion of Milestone 1:

Based on high energy burden, charging station scarcity, personal vehicle reliance, and grid infrastructure, outreach efforts are recommended for Benning Ridge in Ward 7 and Anacostia in Ward 8

 - Overlay housing typology & utility service
 - Expand to other socioeconomic metrics
