


Distributed Generation

- DER Interconnection volume continues to climb year over year driven by the Future Energy Jobs Act
- 2020 resulted in ~10,500 new interconnections (183 MW), primarily rooftop solar along with the first community solar projects in Northern Illinois
- 700% increase in Community solar subscribers since 1/1/2021 with over 7,000+
- Forecasting record Distributed Generation Rebates in 2021 ~59 Million driven by large community solar projects
