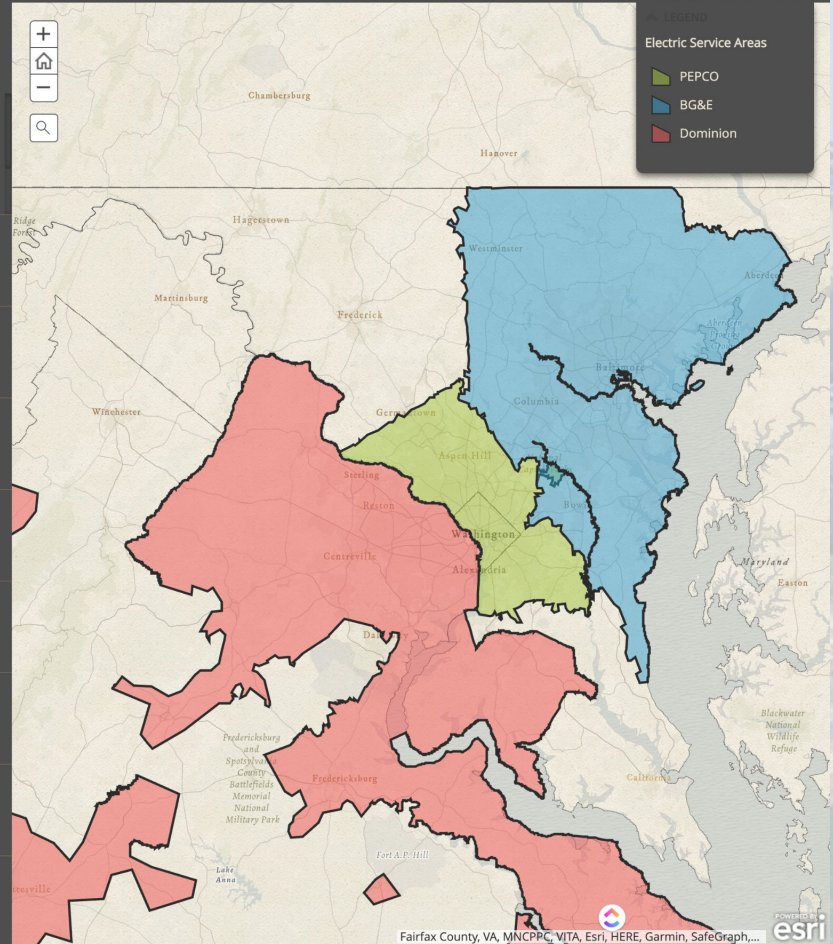

Submit a proposed outline of DC Water projects combining equity, carbon reduction, & vulnerability

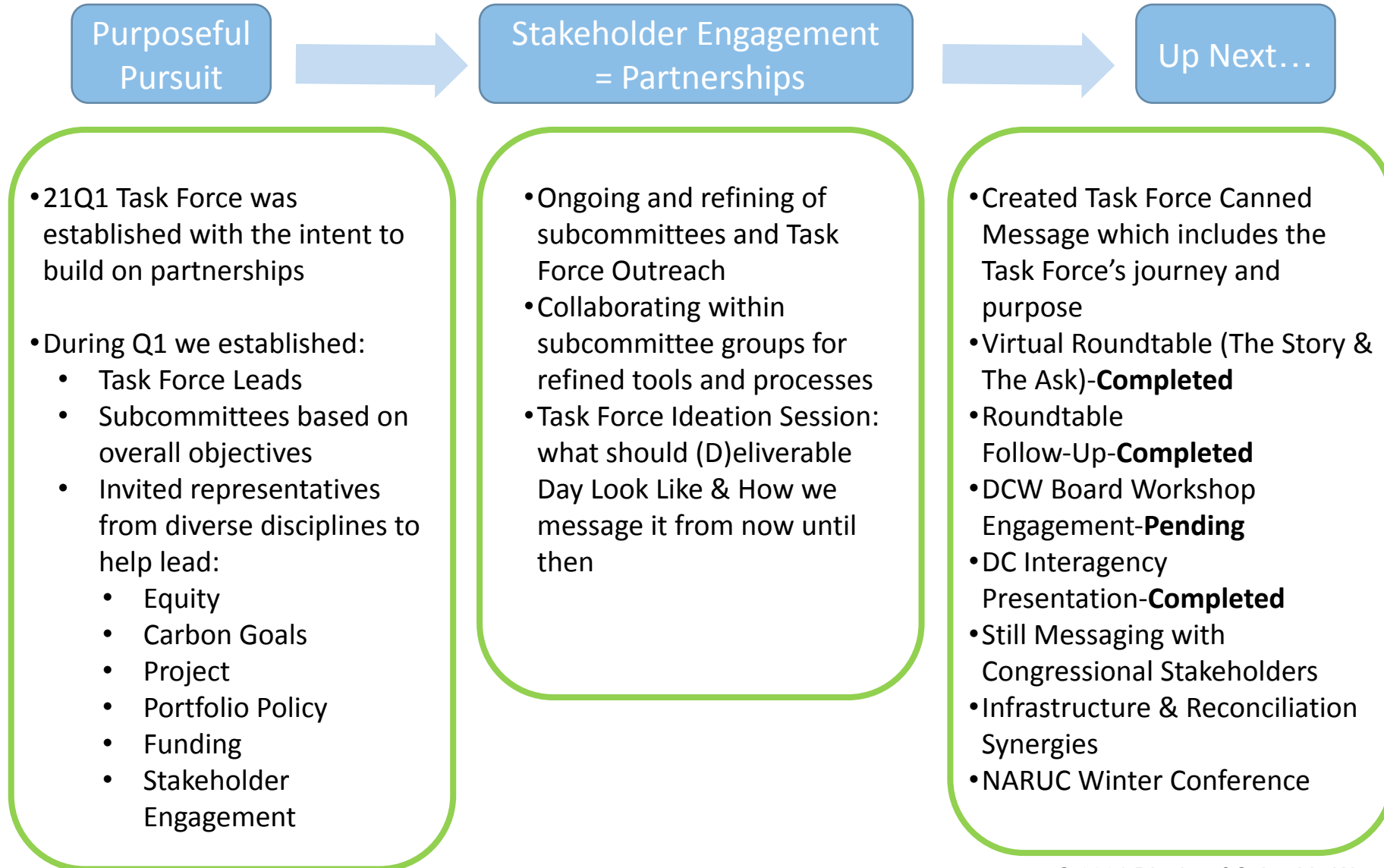
UPDATES:
