"aligning the Blue Plains Microgrid project scope with Justice 40 outcomes and securing federal funds for project implementation in partnership with external stakeholders."









Key Obstacle...

Keeping the engagement momentum!!!

- ☐Transparency: what are we building and why
- □Engagement: ensuring all stakeholders are identified and included (even the ones that don't agree)
- □Alignment: with community resources and needs and funding (may need an internal team dedicated to tracking)

Benefits: The "tea" of any project can help fulfill the projects ultimate plan/goal above and beyond just implementation.

Consequences: Unable to build or delay because there is a lack of understanding and resources available.
