

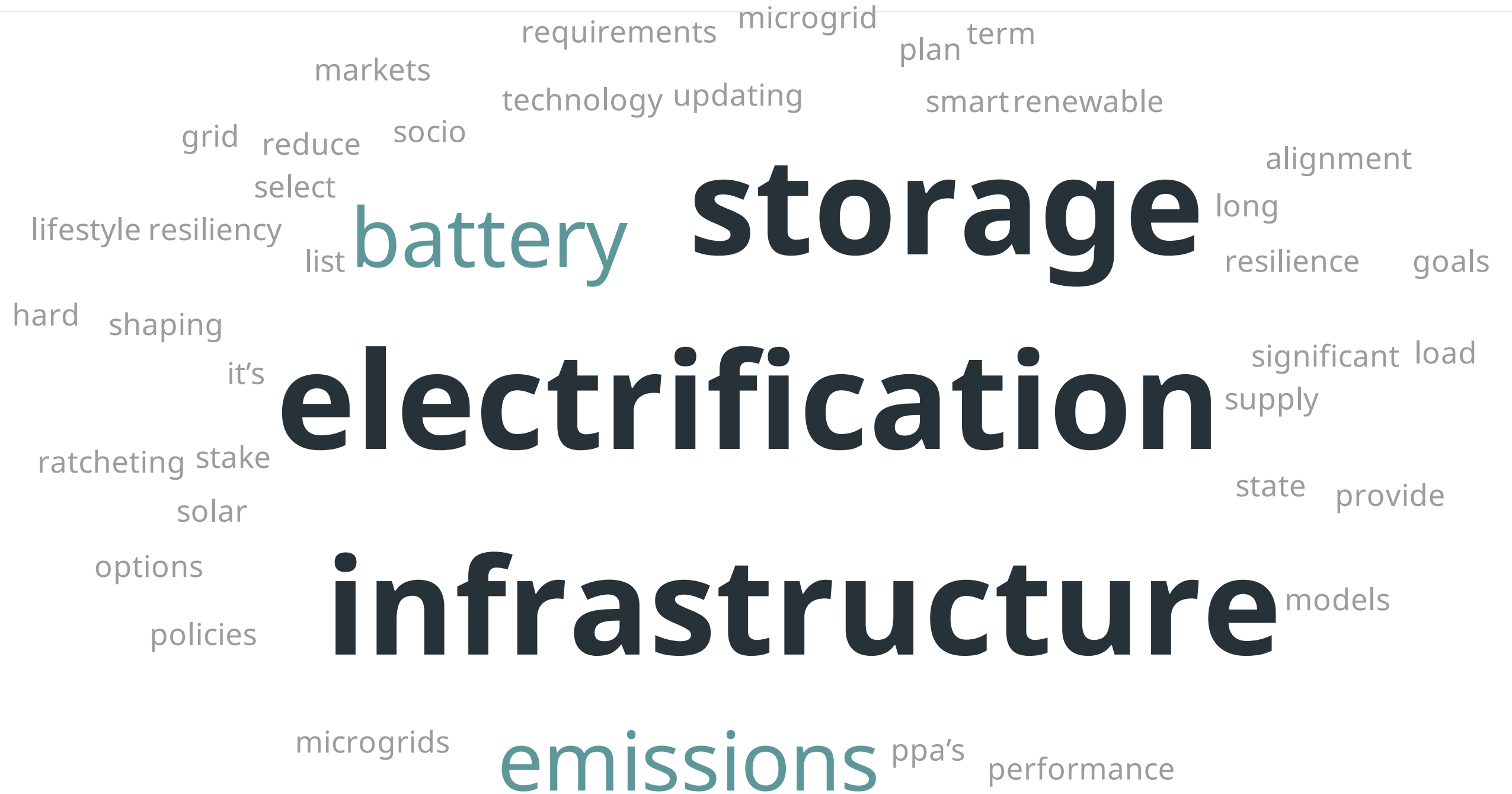

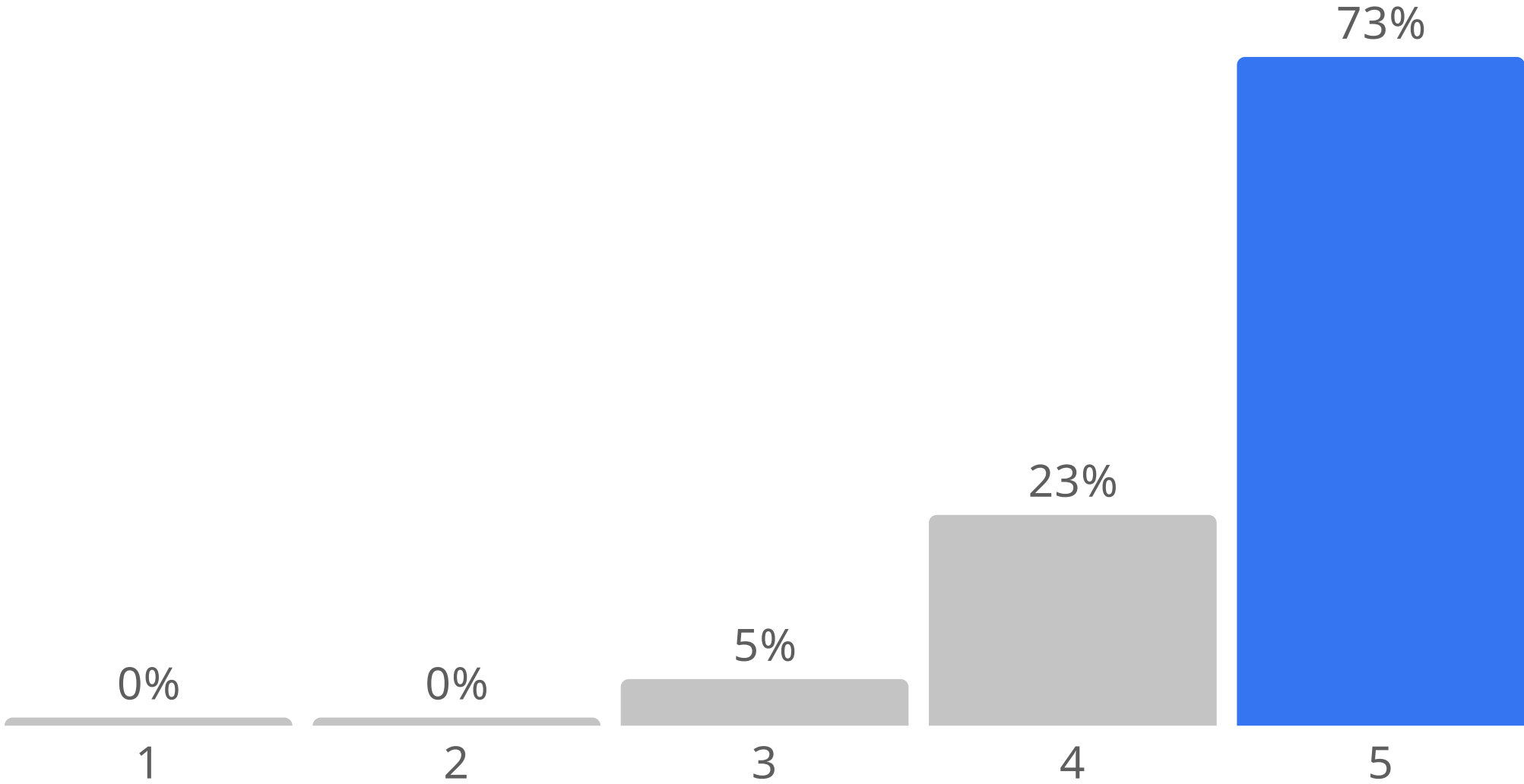
What will have the greatest impact on Boston's decarbonization goal achievement vis-a-vis Resilience, Critical Infrastructure & Microgrids?

How likely are you to recommend AEG events? (5 = very likely)

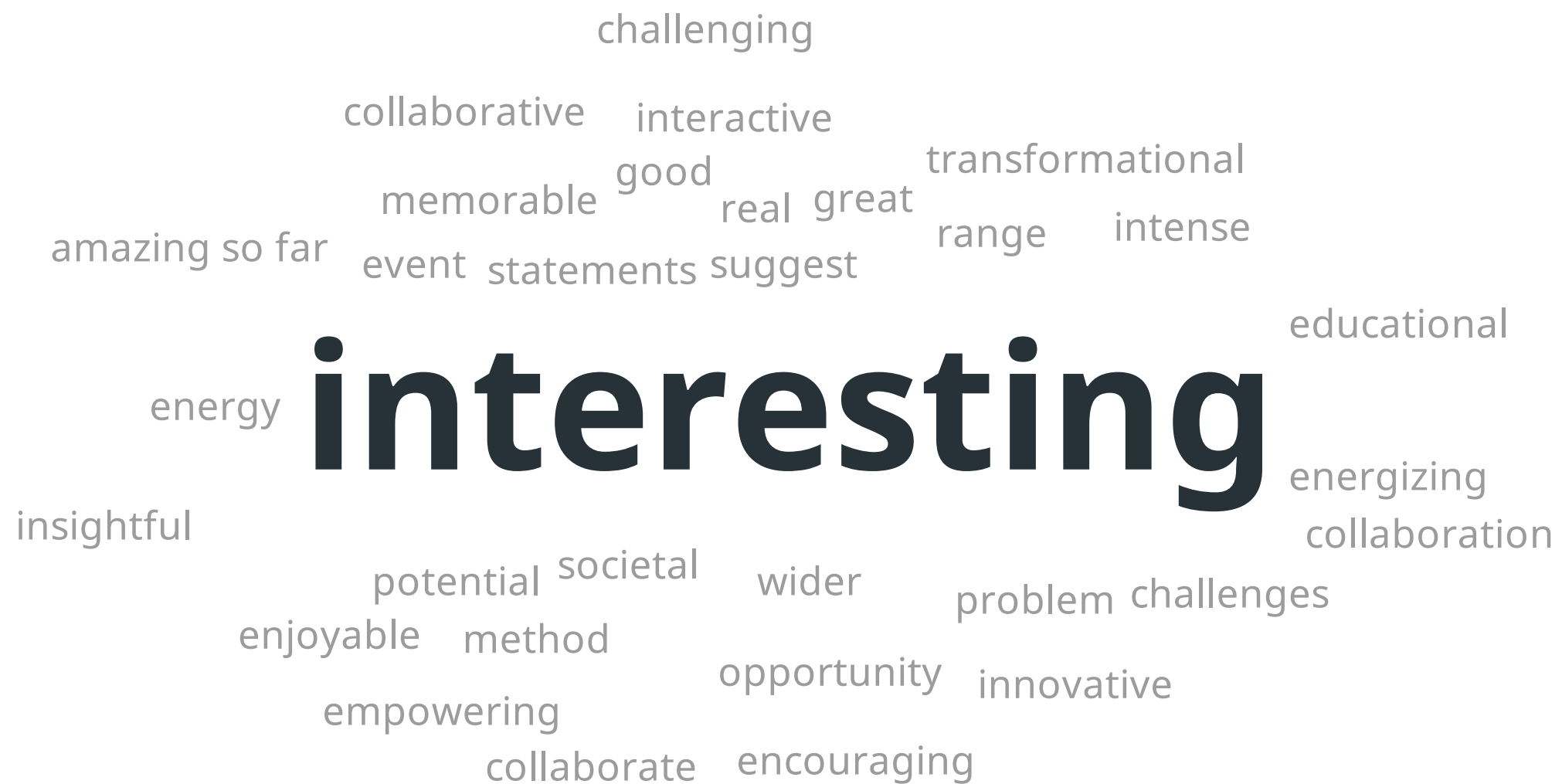
