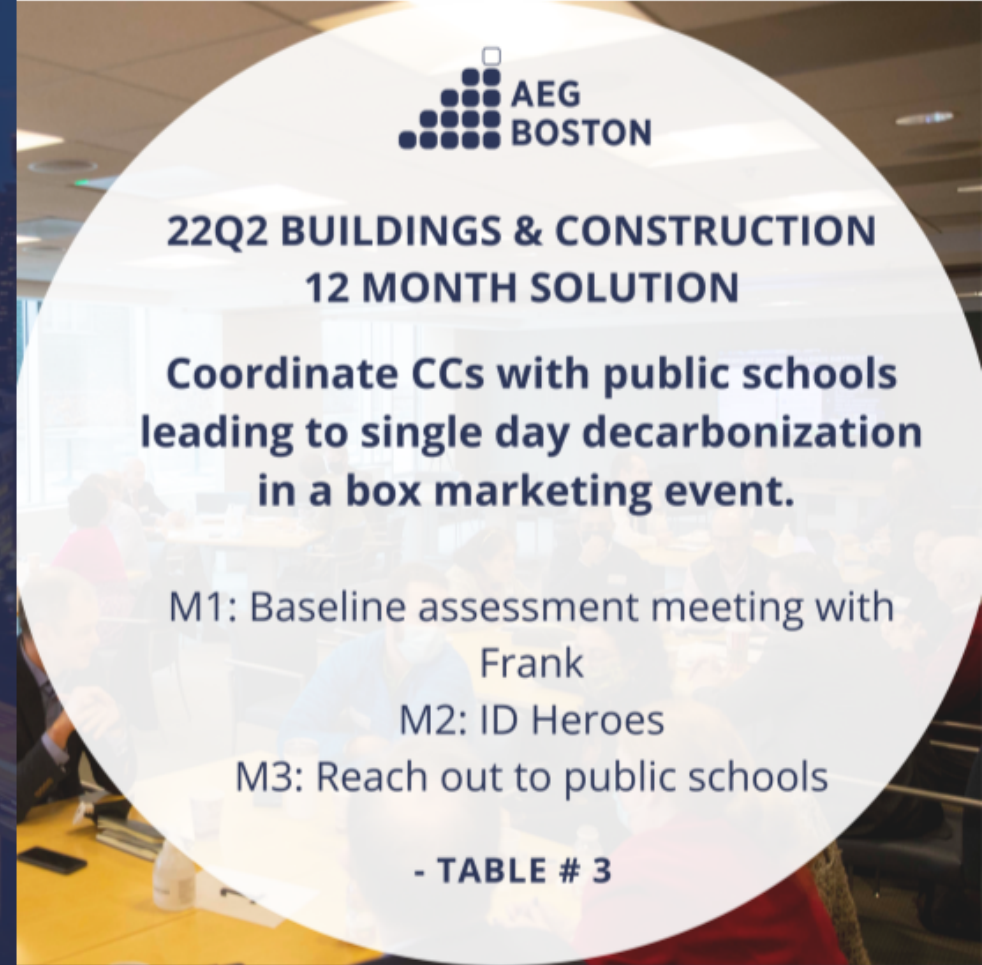

22Q2 TASK FORCE UPDATES



UPDATES:

- RCC kicked off its first entry-level pipeline pilot with Power Corps Boston and A Better City on February 6, 2023. Twelve participants ages 18-30 from environmental justice neighborhoods in Boston (e.g., Roxbury, Mattapan, Dorchester) are attending 18 weeks of combined in-class training and onsite internships with industry partners including Mass General Brigham, Federal Reserve, Dana Farber, Boston Properties, Beacon Capital Properties, Jll among others.

NEXT STEPS:

- At the end of the training, students will compete in a procurement exercise to demonstrate how to measure and benchmark energy performance in building operations, including conducting an energy audit on RCC's campus and comparing it to their internship site. Students will work in small groups and be required to present their results at the end of the cohort.
