NYC Parks 16 Cubic Yard Electric Compacting Collection Truck

Specification:

Intent: It is the intent of this specification to describe a heavy-duty vehicle equipped with a rear loading, 16 cubic yard compacting refuse collection body. The vehicle will be used in a municipal refuse operation for the collection of refuse ranging from light weight material to construction debris and items that may be found in cleaning of vacant lots. The vehicle and its systems must be designed and engineered to work under extended, severe service conditions. It

Regarding Clean Transportation: To Achieve New York's climate, health, and equity goals, a critical obstacle to collectively overcome in 12 Months is lack of collaboration on needs and specifications within the fleet community: Last Mile, Utility / Telecoms, Municipal, Federal Collaborating on: Specifications, Hacks, Vendor Engagement, EVSE
