Our Climate Goals


- **35% reduction of GHGs** by 2025, for PA direct emissions
- **50% reduction of GHGs** by 2030 for PA direct emissions
- Net-zero by 2050 for all GHG emissions





Port Authority Emissions

5.4 million metric tons of CO2e in 2019



- Scopes 1 + 2 = "direct" =
 Emissions in PA's operational control
- Scope 1: Use of fuel onsite (e.g., vehicles)
- Scope 2: Use of electricity, steam at PA facilities, BUT production/emissions are offsite

Scope 3 = "indirect" =


Emissions outside of PA's operational control

• Scope 3: Use of all energy by tenants, partners, customers, associated with PA activities, including vehicle fuel use




PANYNJ 2019 Operational Emissions (Scopes 1&2)

220,262 metric tons of CO2e in 2019










