Harsh Reality...




- US 1.3 billion in losses/226% loss of GDP
- □ 90% of structures damaged; 62% of homes heavily damaged and 15% destroyed
- 100% loss of power; 90% without power for over 4 months

- 24,000 people severely or borderline food insecure
- ☐ 43 out of 44 water systems destroyed
- ☐ Roads impassable; Communities cut-off


The Dominica Solution
