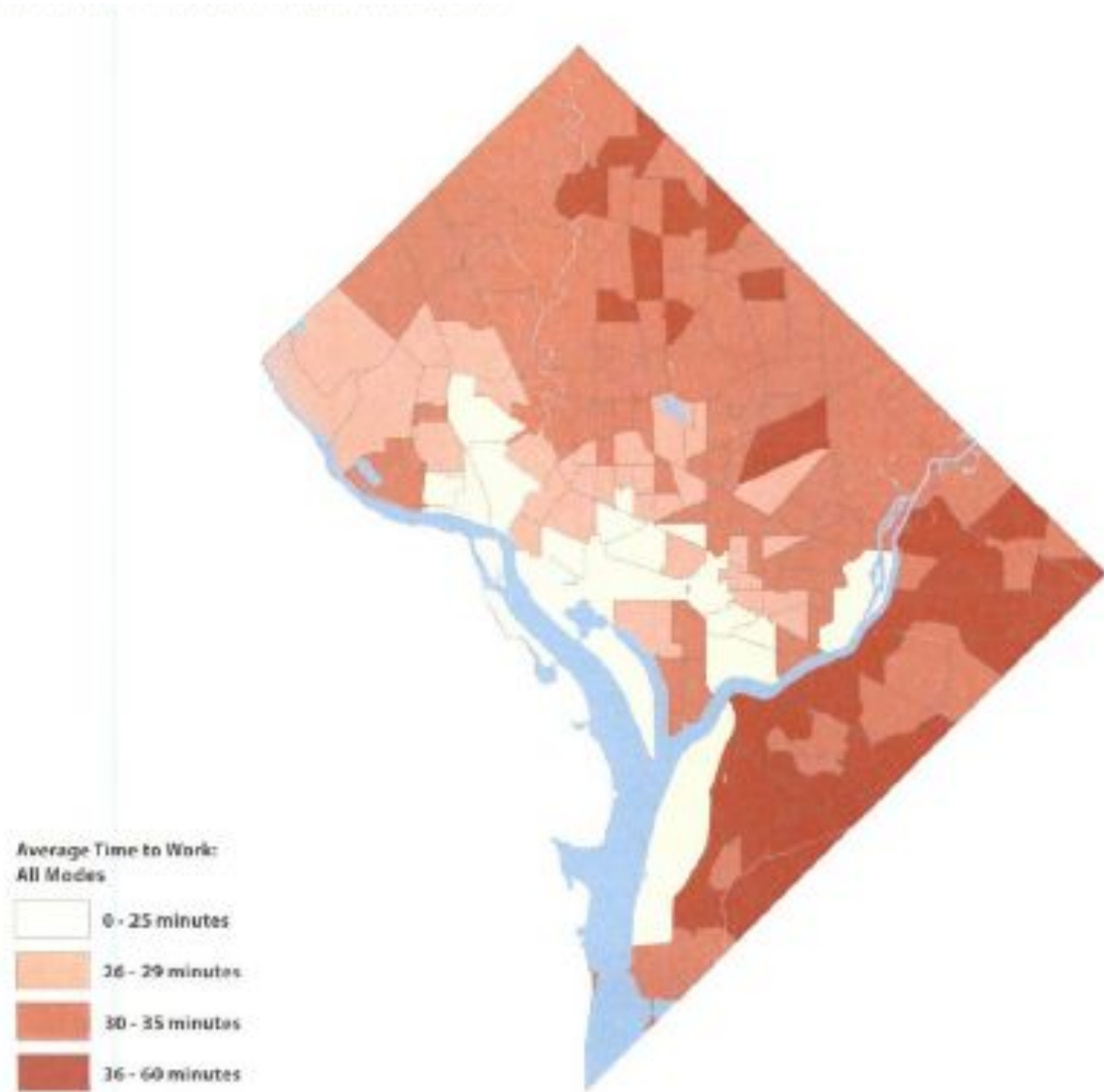
# A Vision for 2050:

All residents have safe, reliable, convenient, and clean transportation options, no matter where they live, when they need to travel, their physical abilities, or their income.

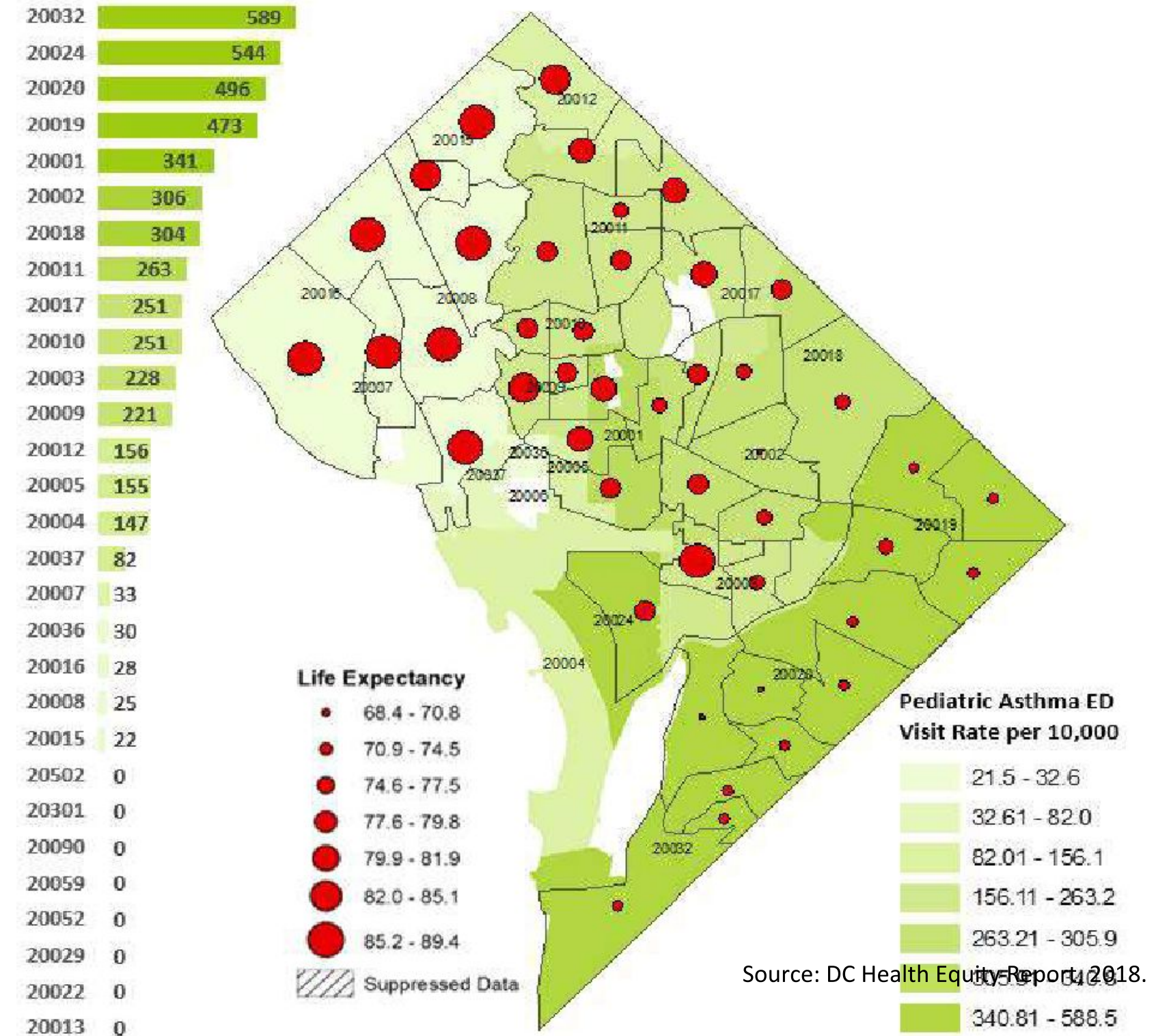


# TRANSPORTATION BURDEN

## PEDIATRIC ASTHMA EMERGENCY ROOM VISITS

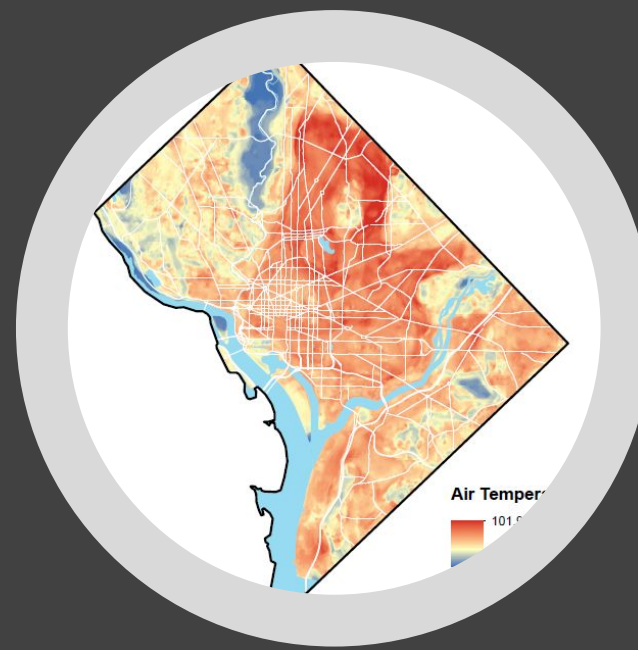

# CLIMATE CHANGE IS HERE

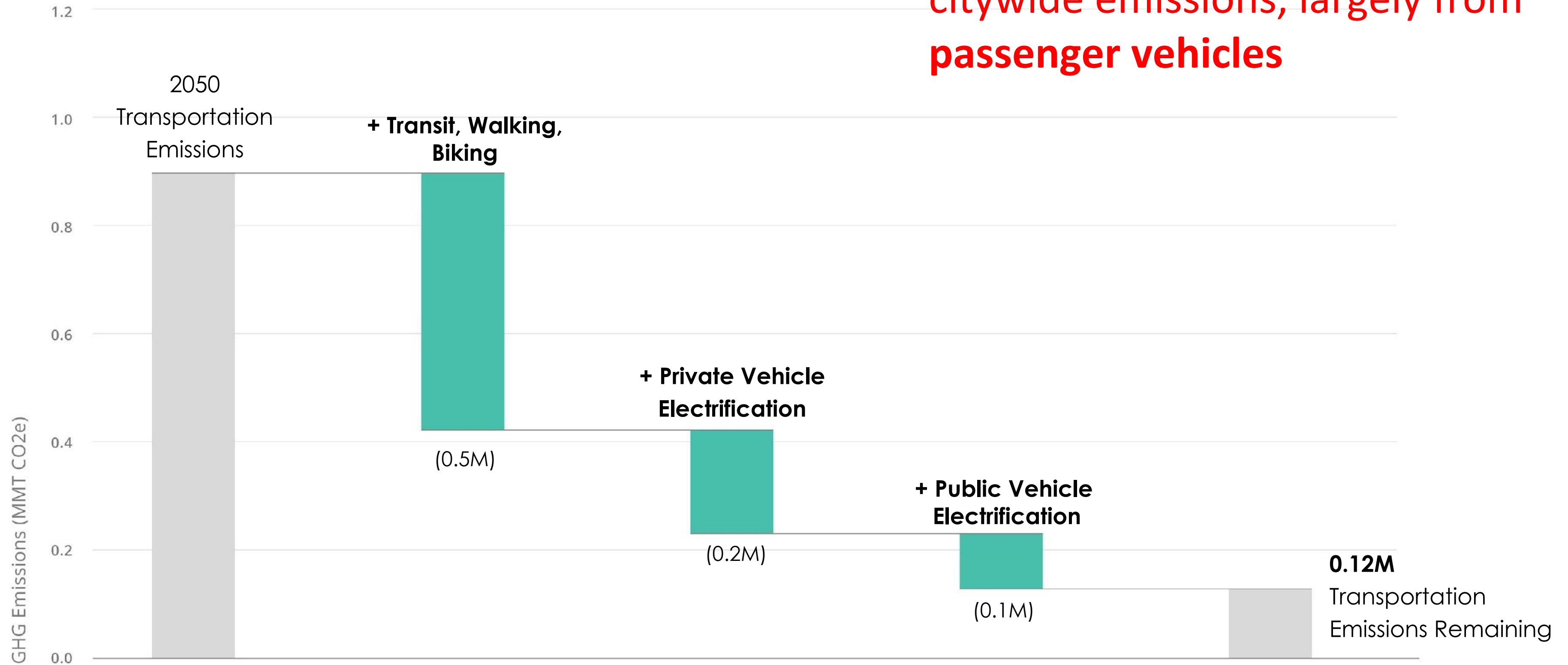
Warmer, Wetter, Wilder Future:
