







## **Methods and Data Sources**

#### Asthma Data

- Aggregate patient addresses by complex
- Count patients, visits by complex

#### Housing Conditions Data


- Pull DCRA data and aggregate by complex
- Combine patient-reported housing concerns from CLC, Asthma Home Visiting Program

#### Map

- Combined asthma and housing conditions data at the complex level
- Include property information (ownership, HUD subsidies)

# **Next Steps**

### The Green, Affordable, and Healthy Housing Project

**Project Team:** National Housing Trust, Children's National Hospital, Children's Law Center, and Skadden Arps

Funder: JP Morgan Foundation

**Scope:** Using the Healthy Housing Map as a primary data source, the project team will identify 10-15 buildings that display high rates of asthma morbidity and unhealthy housing for remediation. Over the next 3 years, several of these eligible multifamily buildings will be remediated and retrofitted as the team studies the health and environmental impacts of these efforts.

### Goals:

- 1) Improve pediatric asthma triggered by air pollution and GHG emissions
- 2) Improve health and wellness outcomes for resident families
