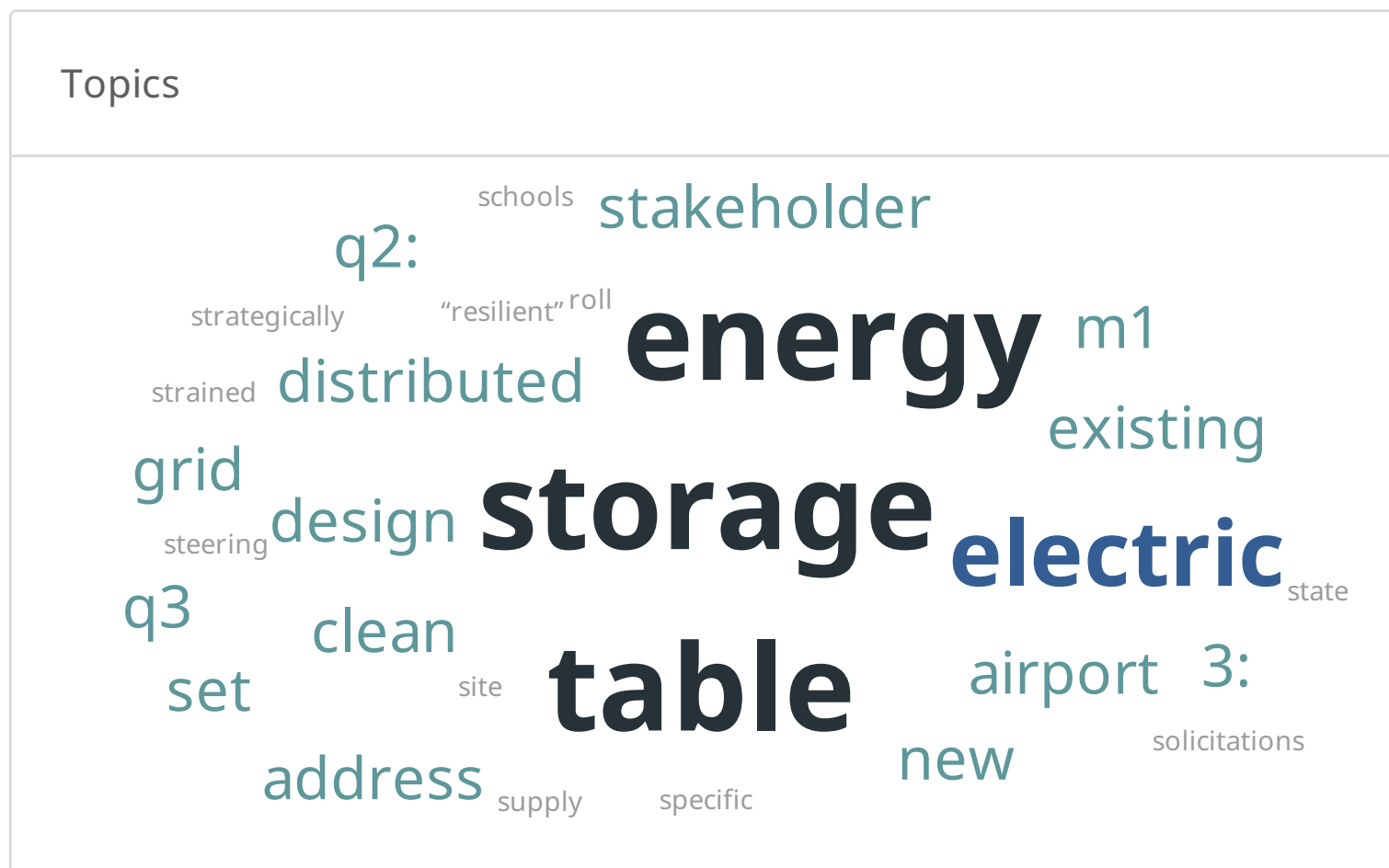

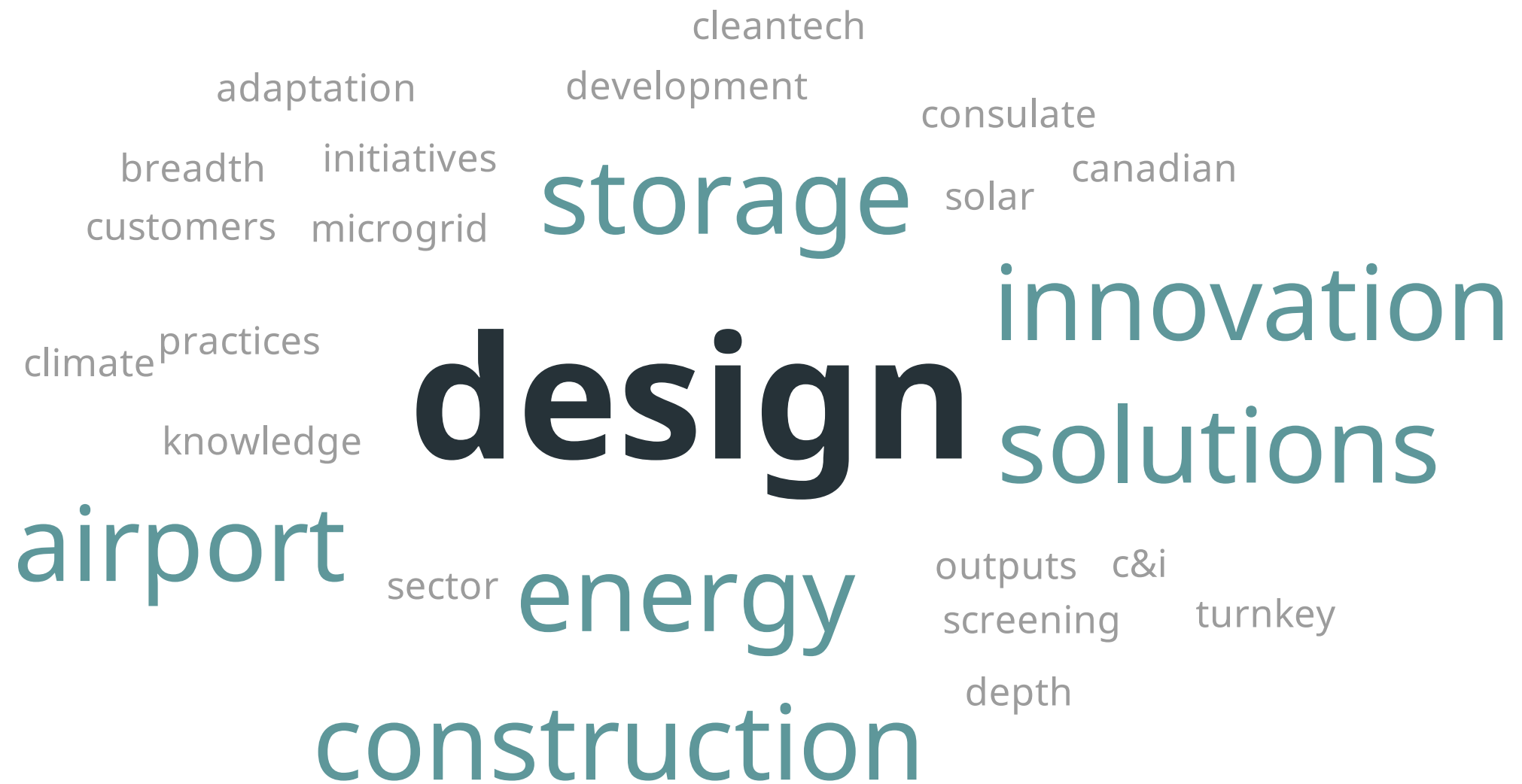

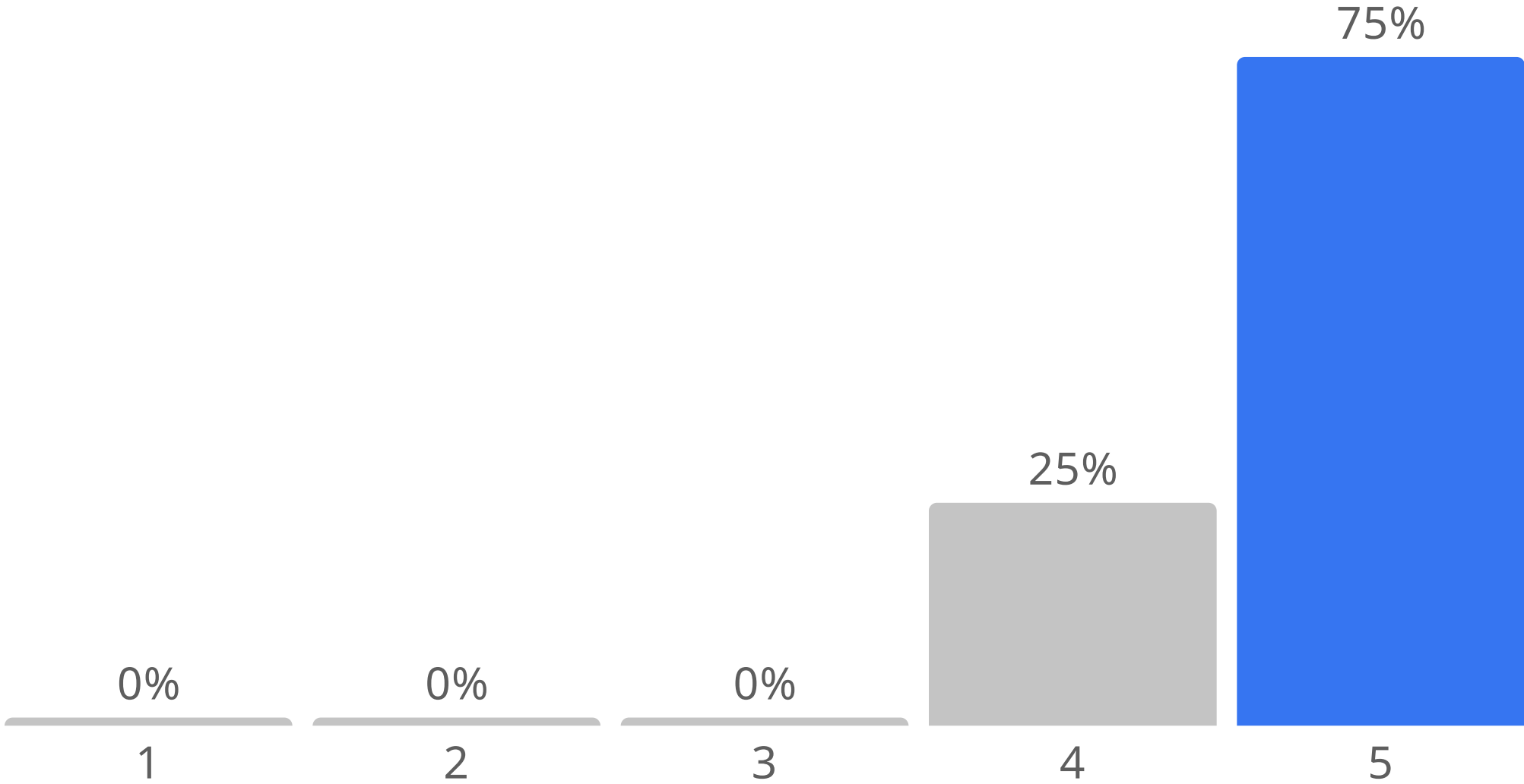
What resource or capability do you bring to the discussion today?
